EK BALAM

At the perfect time when the sun is going down we will explore Ek Balam. It was the seat of a Mayan kingdom. From the Preclassic until the Postclassic period. The site is noted for the preservation of the plaster on the tomb of Ukit Kan Lek Tok', a king buried in the side of the largest pyramid. It eventually became the capital of the polity that controlled the region around the beginning of the Common Era.

The Oval Palace contained burial relics and its alignment is assumed to be connected to cosmological ceremonies. The layout of the site is surrounded by two concentric walls which served as defense against attack

Ek Balam is a magnificent archaeological Site in which you can still climb to its top and make awesome landscape photography from the tree tops of the mayan jungle. Its also a great place to visit because its not crowded as other ruins.
